# Vietnam & Cambodia

Vietnam has a history of changing political circumstances from French domination, to involvement by the United States and Japan. Today, the legacy of wars has been eclipsed by a buzz of tourism, as visitors experience the breathtaking beauty of the north's Red River Delta, the south's Mekong Delta, and the dazzling green rice paddies of the coast. Pristine coastal beaches give way to an interior of soaring mountains and dense forests.

Ancient Cambodia was an important trade link between China and India, today the country reflects influences from both cultures. Cambodians work to preserve their heritage, from traditional textiles to temples and homes. The capital, Phnom Penh, offers insight into ancient times, as well as reminders of the Khmer Rouge regime. One of Asia's most significant historic sites, the Temples of Angkor is a treasure-trove of architecture. Many ruins are accessible from Siem Reap, including legendary Angkor Wat, Bayon, Ta Prom and Angkor Thom.
